ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

The Ashley Chen scholarship is an annual award designed to keep alive, enshrine, and acknowledge the values Ashley consistently demonstrated. It is dedicated to a graduating athlete who combines a high level of skill and on-field competitiveness. The recipient will demonstrate similar strength of character in addition to a positive attitude toward the game, coaches, officials, teammates, and opponents on the field as well as in off field activities.

Like Ashley, this hardworking athlete will also have combined their on-field dedication with fairness, compassion for others, humility, and good-naturedness off the field. The **\$3,000** scholarship will be awarded to a Grade 12 student proceeding to any post-secondary institution. The scholarship is conditional on proof of attendance at the post-secondary institution. In order to be eligible to receive this scholarship, the player must have been registered with the Richmond District this past season and be a Richmond resident.
